


Tourism Works For New York Counties



Spending by visitors to New York grew 8.7% in 2010 to \$49.8 billion.

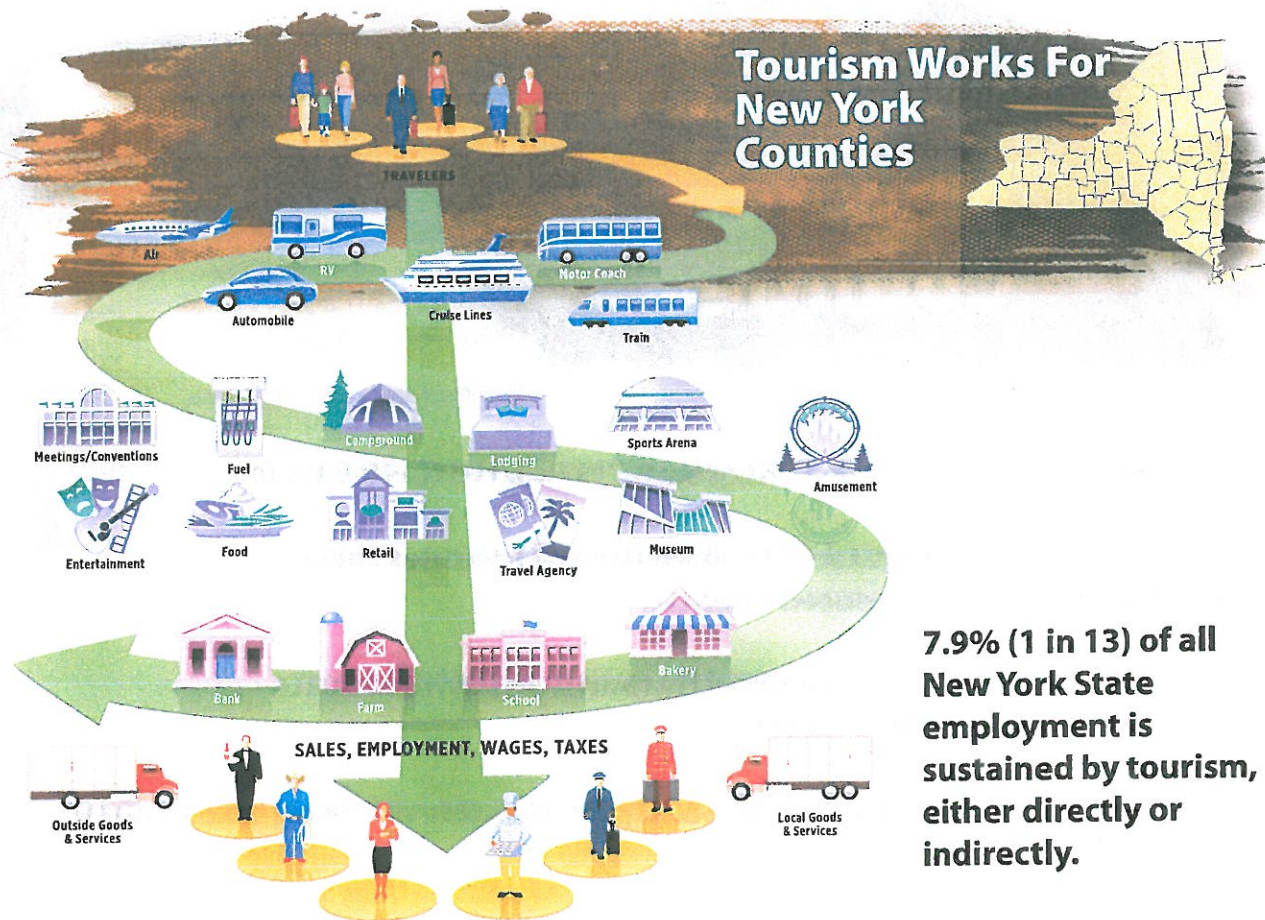
Tourism spending generated \$81 billion in total business sales including indirect and induced impacts.

Nearly 674,000 jobs were sustained by tourism activity in 2010 with total income of \$26.5 billion.

New York State tourism generated \$6.5 billion in state and local taxes in 2010.
